



# **IAVA 2010 ANTAKSHARI COMPETITION**

## **ENTRY FORM**

**Eligibility:**           **Two (2) members per team**

**Entry Rules:**       *By providing this entry form the team members confirm that they have read the following rules and they abide by these rules.*

- The format and detailed rules of the competition will be provided by March 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- A maximum of 15 teams comprising of 2 members each will compete.
- There will be three Semi-final games, involving five teams of two players each.
- The top two teams from each of the Semi-final games will play in the Final game.
- The top three teams in the Final game will be awarded cash prizes.
- Each team will be tested on the knowledge of Bollywood music from Hindi films.
- It is NOT a singing competition, but the participants are still expected to sing in tune.
- No interaction with audience.
- No interaction with members of other teams.
- Misbehavior by any member will disqualify the whole team.
- No argument with the Emcees or Judges or Scorer, Emcees will decide the score.
- There will be multiple rounds of competition.
- The order of teams in each game will be determined by lottery.
- The starting team for each round will also be selected by lottery.
- Scores for all teams from each round will be provided at the completion of that round.
- In case of controversy, Judges' decisions will be final and binding.
- Breaking any of the rules will cost negative points.
- The organizers will be responsible for the accuracy of the scores.
- The program may use experts and technology to ascertain the accuracy of team responses.
